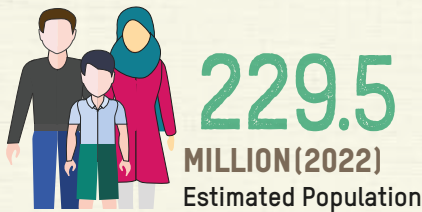
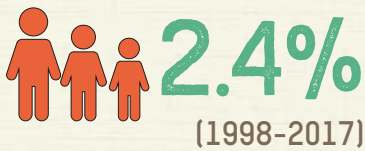


CURRENT STATE OF PAKISTAN'S POPULATION

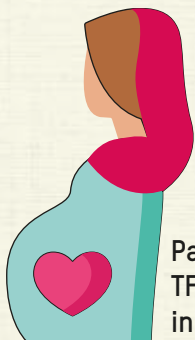

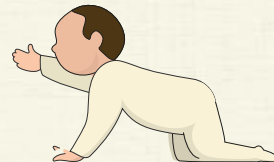

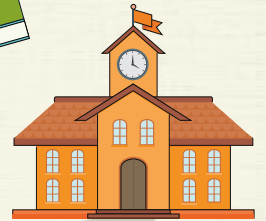
